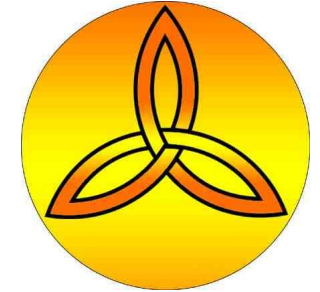
On Wednesday it is the last Cafe Church before the summer break and when we say farewell to Steve Santry.
